CAPTAIN AMBROSE THOMAS NORMAN ABBAY DSO (1899-1900)

He was born on 10 November 1886 and is the brother of Captain Marmaduke Abbay (1899-1902).

Instead of going into the Army like his brother, he went into the Royal Navy and during WW1 was mentioned in dispatches.

He was awarded the Distinguished Service Order on 8 March 1920 $^{\circ}$ For distinguished services in command of HMS Walker – Services in the Baltic 1919."

He retired from the Royal Navy in 1932 and died in 1966.

A white ensign is laid up in Earl Soham church with the following inscription "This ensign was worn by HMS Walker, Lt Commander ATN Abbay RN during the campaign of the British Light Naval Forces against the Russian Bolsheviks in the Baltic 1920."
