

## CAPTAIN JOHN WINGFIELD (WINTFIELD) REYNOLDS (1884-86)

We are indebted to Andy Pritchatt for investigating more information on this OF who has no entry in the CWGC records. This is his report :

I'm finally back to looking for the men on the Framlingham College Memorial, and one of the anomalies I had was Captain J W Reynolds. I could find no trace of him; there were no military records or an entry on the CWGC site which was a bit worrying...

However, after some lateral thinking, I believe I have now identified him – only thing is, he wasn't a Captain, nor was he in the King Edward Horse Yeomanry.

The key to the mystery was finding the 1891 Census entry for a John W Reynolds living at 55 Sherriff Road, Hampstead, and who was Veterinary Student. It was his place of birth, Austria, which was somewhat unexpected but opened things up a bit more.

From that, I found the following:

John Wintfield Reynolds (NOT Wingfield) was born in Austria in 1869 and baptised on 14<sup>th</sup> April 1870. His parents were George Reynolds and his wife, Sophia Ellen Blinkhorn. George was employed as Master of the Horse to the Prince of Lichtenstein (so possibly where the reference to King Edward's Horse came from).

The next time he turns up is in the 1914 Army list where he is shown as a Temporary Lieutenant in the Army Veterinary Corps. It doesn't look like he ever served overseas as no medals appear to have been issued to him or his family.

He sadly died in the Netherne Asylum, Mertsam, Surrey on 16<sup>th</sup> January 1918.
