COMMANDER CYRIL GEORGE NEEVES OBE (G10-15)

He was born on 2 July 1899 and joined the Royal Navy after leaving the College.

During WW1 he served in the Royal Navy and remained in there for the rest of his career. He was Secretary to Assistant Chief of Naval Staff (1931-33); to Rear Admiral Commanding 1^{st} Cruiser Squadron (1933-35); to Assistant Chief of Naval Staff (1937-39); to Rear Admiral 2^{nd} Battle Squadron (1939).

At the start of WW2 he was involved with the North Russian Convoys and Secretary to Rear Admiral 3rd Battle Squadron (1939-41). Then Secretary to Vice Admiral 18th Cruiser Squadron (1942); Secretary to Vice Admiral of Malta (1943) and finally Assistant Secretary (Military) to the War Cabinet (1944-46).

He was awarded OBE on 1 January 1947.
