DAVID DARLINGTON KITTERMASTER (HON OF)

He was appointed Brandeston's first Headmaster in January 1948, having previously been the Headmaster of the Junior School of King's School, Worcester.

He retired in July 1968 and during his 20 years in office achieved the following :-

- Grew pupil number to 102 boarders and 39 day boys
- Built a separate house for the Headmaster
- Converted the old stables into classrooms
- Built up every activity and interest from nothing stamp collecting to bell ringing, drama, music, games, the library, film making and the annual Brandeston Village Fete

He did all these things in addition to teaching and administration, with "complete assurance and great good humour and the complete involvement of his wife in everything he undertook" [Les Gillett – 2^{nd} 60 years]
