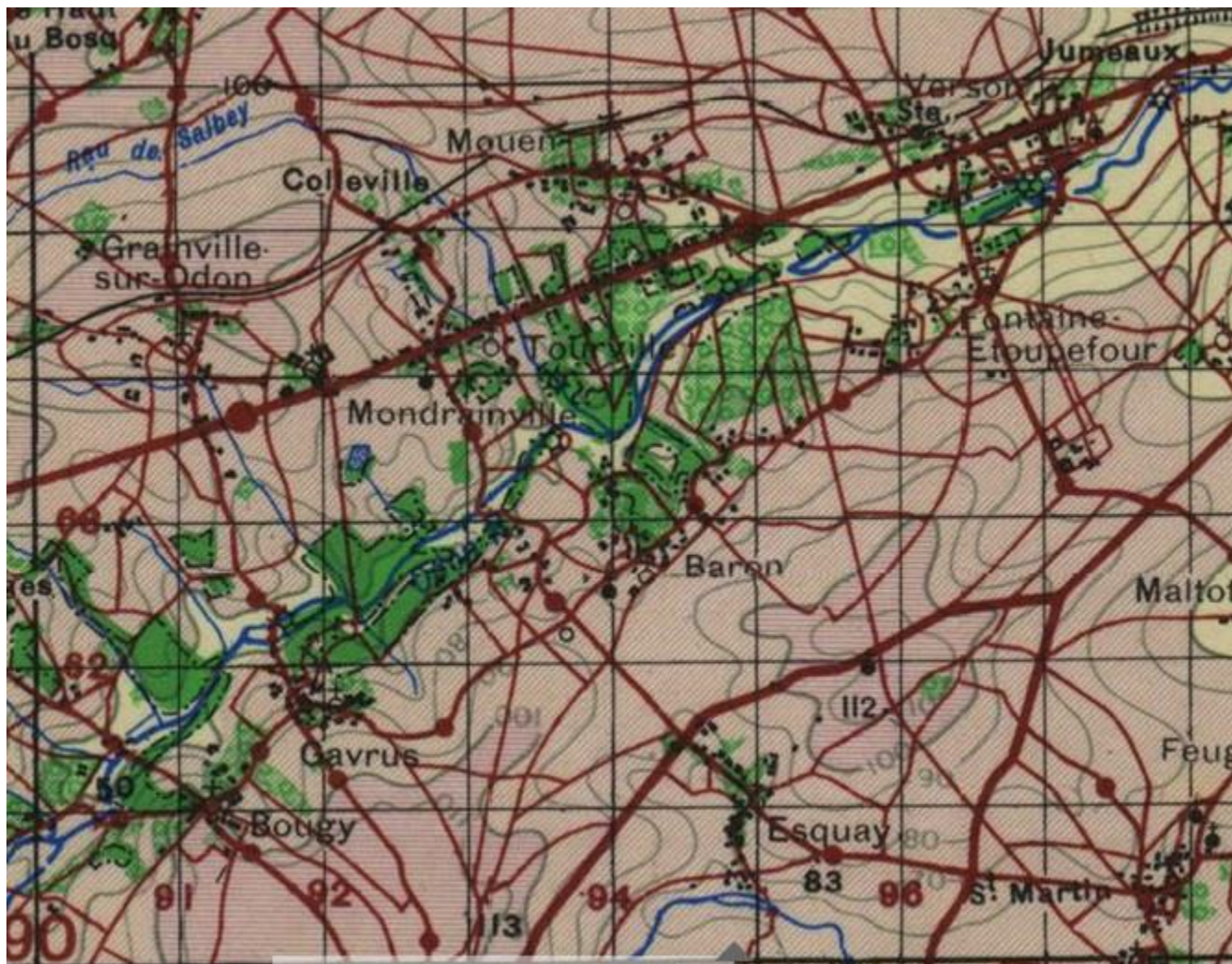




The [Barnsley Memorial website](#) carries the following additional details :
