REVD RUPERT H W KNEESE (HON OF)

He joined the College in 1920 as Chaplain and went on to become Second Master and a Housemaster.

He founded the Scout movement at the College by forming the Second Framlingham Scout Troop in 1922. He was also coach to the OTC and the Scouts.

He was made an Honorary OF in 1942.

He retired from the College in Easter 1953 after nearly 33 years service.

Soon after his retirement he married the mother of W H Franklin DFC (33-38), who was killed during WW2.

He died in July 1957, just four years after retiring and a memorial service was held in the College Chapel. He left a bequest which was used to buy a lectern.
