ROBERT BOULTER CMG OBE (R1897-1901)

The following is taken from the 1968 Register.

He was born on 6 April 1885 and after leaving Framlingham went into the Civil Service.

He entered the British Consular Service in Japan in 1907. He was made a Companion of the Order of St Michael and St George (CMG) in 1923. He was the Commercial Secretary at the British Embassy in Tokyo from 1925 to 1929, followed by the Trade Commissioner in Singapore from 1929 to 1934, followed by the Trade Commissioner in New Zealand.

His final role before retiring was as Economic Adviser to the High Commissioner in New Zealand in 1945. On 1 January 1946 he was awarded the OBE "For services to HM Government in New Zealand during the War."

He died in 1973.
