After leaving the College he trained at the Britannia Royal Naval College. He is a graduate of the prestigious Royal College of Defence Studies, where he was awarded the Wellington Prize for Strategic Analysis.

He has more than three decades' experience both on land and at sea. Previous roles have included active duty in Afghanistan, deployments to the Far East, submarine patrols, secondments to NATO, the UK Ministry of Defence and the National Security Secretariat.

He was promoted to Commodore on 1 May 2015 and served as British Defence attaché in Kyiv. He was at the frontline of the UK's support to the Ukrainian military. In Kyiv he also served as Head of the British Defence Staff in Eastern Europe, commanding all Defence Attaches across Belarus, Moldova, Georgia, Armenia, Azerbaijan and Ukraine at a defining moment in European security.



He was promoted to rear admiral on 16 January 2023, and became Head of the British Defence Staff and Defence Attaché in Washington, D.C. the same month. He leads the UK's extensive military engagement and partnerships across all branches of the United States military.

He was appointed a Commander of the Order of the British Empire in the 2023 Birthday Honours.
